VOLUNTEER AND COACHING OPPORTUNITIES









To get a soccer program off the ground for the 2018 season, we need volunteers to assist with:

- Registration;
- Coaching (Head and Assistant Coaches);
- Coordinating Equipment.

Without volunteers, especially coaches, we won't be able to run our program! If you are interested in volunteering your time to help kids in your community play soccer, please email us directly at soccer@inglewoodcl.com.

The season runs from May through June 2018. The time commitment during these two months will vary depending on the age of kids on the team (e.g. younger kids play and practice less often).

Never coached before? Training for coaching and assistant coaching is provided through EWZSA. Also, individuals under the age of 18 are allowed to coach, under certain conditions. **Please contact us for more information.**

Please note: All new coaches, assistant coaches and managers require a security clearance form to be completed before the season starts. REGISTRATION TO PLAY



ONLINE PORTAL

Step 1: Register Online with the Edmonton West Zone Soccer Association

Outdoor soccer registration for all players across the Edmonton West Zone Soccer Association (EWSZA) will take place online **between February 1 -28, 2018**. All players regardless of community **must register** through EWZSA's registration online portal by visiting: http://emsawest.com/play/register/outdoor-registration/.

Note: You need a valid Community League membership in hand. Please select this link above and follow the instructions to complete the 2018 registration form for your child. Print **two** copies of your "Confirmation of Registration" from the EWZSA website and bring these to our community payment night (see Step 2). Please register your little ones online with EWZSA as soon as possible.

PAYMENT NIGHTS

Step 2: Pay the Registration Fee

Once your child is registered, you will need to pay the fee required by the EWZSA. **Please note that the EWZSA** is **NOT** able to accept payment of soccer fees online at this time. For this reason, the Inglewood Community League will be hosting community payment night on:

REMEMBER TO BRING TO PAYMENT NIGHT:

Regardless of which payment night you attend, please bring these items with you.

- Two copies of the registration confirmation from the EWZSA Portal (see Step 1)
- Alberta Health Care Card for verification of player Birth Date
- Payment for Soccer Fees (CASH or CHEQUE ONLY)

NOTE: If you are unable to register online for whatever reason, League and EWZSA representatives will be on hand at both the Community Payment Nights and Central Registration Payment Night to help you through the online registration process.

TEAM FORMATION

It is our hope that every kid from Inglewood will have an opportunity to play for Inglewood. However, the number of teams Inglewood can put together will depend on the number of kids registering and the number of volunteers and coaches that come forward.

If Inglewood is not able to host /field a team due to a lack of players OR coaching staff; EWZSA will place players on another team in the West Zone OR you may choose to play for another league team. **Please note:**

- If players choose to play for another community league team, fees charged by that community league will apply.
- If Inglewood players are placed on another team by EWZSA, additional fees may apply.

FEES

To kick-start the soccer program this year, the Inglewood Community League is offering a subsidized rate for players that are members of the Inglewood Community League. The subsidized fees are outlined in the table below.

Note: Subsidized fees will only be in effect and applicable if the league can find at least one coach, one assistant coach and the minimum number of players for an age category to host a team.
