Petition to Expand Pogo Car Share Zone to Inglewood and Westmount

Pogo is a car-share service that provides members with the ability to rent vehicles for short periods of time to do things such as run errands, commute to work or school, attend social activities, or take day trips. The company's goal is to give members access to a clean, well-maintained car on their own terms without the escalating costs of car ownership.

Part of Pogo's ease of use is members can pick up and drop off Pogo's vehicles on any street that permits parking within Edmonton's central and surrounding neighbourhoods. Currently, the northern edge of this parking zone is 108 Avenue.

Pogo has expressed interest to expand its Zone but wants assurances that any such Zone expansion would also lead to expansion in their number of members.

A petition has been created for people to indicate if they would consider using the service if Pogo expanded its zone to Inglewood and Westmount. For more info about Pogo visit <https://pogocarshare.com/>

Note that this petition has been organized by a Pogo member living in Inglewood. While Pogo has been notified of its existence and declared that such a petition would be a good method of gauging public interest, the petition is not officially affiliated with the company.
