The City is renewing roads, sidewalks and streetlights in Inglewood in 2019–2021 and considering other improvements on City-owned land. We would like your help in refining a project vision and important elements, and want to hear what we should consider as we renew the infrastructure in your neighbourhood.



We normally only send out one *Inglewords* newsletter a month, but this event is too important not to share with you.

Neighbourhood renewal is a 3-year project to upgrade a neighbourhood's entire infrastructure. Streets, sidewalks, and streetlights throughout the neighbourhood will be replaced or upgraded.

More recently, the City renamed renewal to "Building Great Neighbourhoods." The "Building Great Neighbourhoods" program can help a community address local needs and reinforce its character and identity. Additional projects can include city-owned lands and improvements.

To help the city develop a focus and plan for Inglewood, a number of stakeholder and engagement sessions were held in March and April.

At the Engagement Session on Saturday, April 21, over 100 people came out to share their ideas and thoughts for what would help Inglewood become "Great".

One final Engagement Session is coming up this Wednesday, April 25 from 6:30 - 9:00 pm at the Winnifred Stewart Association, 11130 131 Street.

This is a drop-in workshop, it includes seven different stations for you to visit. We recommend that you spend at least 1.5 hours at the workshop. Light refreshments, snacks and children's activities will be provided.
