St. Albert Trail to 97 Street

August 25, 2026

Project Overview

As part of the Yellowhead Trail Freeway Conversion Program, the City of Edmonton is continuing work between St. Albert Trail and 97 Street. Ultimately, Yellowhead Trail will have three lanes of free flowing traffic in each direction with new interchanges at 127 Street and 121 Street.

Purpose of Bulletin

To provide awareness of construction activities impacting 121 and 107 Streets along Yellowhead Trail taking place from September 1 through late Fall 2026.

Upcoming Activities

- Roadway reconstruction along the existing 121 Street
- Adjustment of Yellowhead Trail alignment to connect new roadways to new 121 Street intersection alignment.

Traffic Accommodation (Map Attached)

- Complete 121 Street closure from Via Rail to Yellowhead Trail.
 - Local traffic only from 118 Avenue to Via Rail access
- CN Walker Yard access will be reduced to right in / right out with no left turns
- Addition of a left-turn lane from Yellowhead Trail Westbound to 107 Street southbound.
- Northbound 107 Street to Westbound Yellowhead Trail dual left turns will be reestablished.
- Emergency access will be maintained at all times.
